	<p><u>Hepworth FP9</u></p> <p>Commencing on the northern side of Beck Street (U6412), opposite the property known as Dormer Cottage at grid reference 98797602, progressing in a general northerly direction, along a natural surface track, within a grass lane, following along the eastern side of hedgerow/trees and the western side of a drain and field parcel No. 9110 for approximately 70 metres to grid reference 98827609, then continuing in the same direction along a natural surface track within a grass sunken lane, following along the western side of a drain, with field parcel No. 7121 to the west and field parcel No. 9110 to the east for approximately 50 metres to grid reference 98827614, then changing to a general north easterly direction along natural surface track, within a grass sunken lane, following along the northern side of a drain, with field parcel No. 7121 to the north and field parcel No. 9110 to the south for approximately 30 metres to cross the drain into field parcel No. 9110 at grid reference 98857616, continuing in the same direction, following along the southern side of a drain, crossing drains along the north western edges of field parcel Nos. 9110, 0224, 1427 and 1734 for approximately 402 metres to the Thelnetham parish boundary to connect with Thelnetham FP12 at grid reference 99137644.</p>
