Commencing from the Thelnetham parish boundary at grid reference 99737676, crossing a drain in a general north-north-westerly direction, up an incline, along the eastern edge of field parcel number 6400, following along the western side of a drain and then hedgerow and drain for approximately 269 metres to the north-eastern corner of the same field at grid reference 99667702; changing to a general northerly direction, up an incline, passing across the south-eastern corner of field parcel number 0006 for approximately 40 metres to the eastern edge of the same field at grid reference 99667706; changing to a general north-north-westerly direction and continuing up the incline along the eastern edge of the same field, following the western side of a drain for approximately 145 metres to a gap in the hedgerow at the north-eastern corner of field parcel number 0006 at grid reference 99637720; then on level ground curving in a general north-easterly direction, following the western side of a drain at the south-eastern corner of field parcel number 5423 for approximately 45 metres to join the southern side of the C638 road adjacent to Weathercock Farm at grid reference 99657724.
