| | <p>Commencing on the southern side of the C643 road at grid reference 91657499, the tarmacadam road progressing in a general south-south-easterly direction and passing between the properties of Lampitt Way for approximately 65 metres to grid reference 91687493.</p> <p>Continuing in the same direction as a hedge lined lane for approximately 95 metres to grid reference 91717484, then in a south easterly direction with pasture land field parcel numbers 7770, 9053 and 9544 to the south and grassland field parcel number 8073, spinney field parcel No. 8373 and the Old Rectory to the north, crossing over the cattle grid for approximately 490 metres to grid reference 92017426.</p> <p>The tarmacadam road then changing to a general south-south-easterly direction and proceeding across pasture land at field parcel No. 0044 for approximately 130 metres to grid reference 92057434.</p> <p>At this point leaving the road, and continuing in the same direction across a grass area for approximately 65 metres and leading to St Andrew's Church gate at grid reference 92067428.</p> | | | |

Sapiston Byway 7

Commencing at grid reference TL93687685 on the northern side of the C644 road and progressing in a generally north-westerly direction through field parcel no. 6492 as a tree-lined natural surface track known as Wood Lane for a distance of approximately 171 metres; continuing in the same general direction alongside the eastern edge of a pond through field parcel no. 5116 for a distance of approximately 350 metres to Euston parish boundary and the junction with byway 3 Euston at grid reference TL93447730 (total distance approximately 521 metres).

Width: as shown by the boundaries on Ordnance Survey Sheet 23/6 Second Edition (1904) scale 1:2500, varying between a minimum of 8 metres and a maximum of 9 metres.

Sapiston Footpath 8

Commencing at O.S. grid reference TL91987503 at the junction with the C643 and progressing in a south-easterly and then southerly direction for 427 metres along a path to O.S. grid reference TL92087463; changing to a south-westerly direction and continuing along a path for 167 metres to the junction with Sapiston footpath 3 at O.S. grid reference TL91937456.

Width: 3 metres between O.S. grid references TL91987503 and TL92087463.

1.8 metres between O.S. grid references TL92087463 and TL91937456.

Limitations: 0.5 metres clearance between staggered wooden railings at junction with C643 at O.S. grid reference TL91987503.
